Questions for Families

Here are some questions you can discuss with the whole family.

Acts 17:1-9

Why did Paul go to the synagogue first in Thessalonica?

Guide your child to see that Paul started there because people knew about God. Younger kids can think about familiar places to talk with friends, while older ones might discuss sharing ideas with people who have similar backgrounds.

How did Paul help people understand who Jesus is?

Encourage younger kids by comparing it to explaining a favorite story. Older kids can talk about how explaining and reasoning helps change minds.

Why were some people mad at Paul and Silas, and what should we do when we're challenged for doing right?

For younger kids, relate it to saying no when something isn't good, while older kids can discuss the importance of sticking to beliefs despite challenges.
