### 1 Peter 3:19

- What was Jesus doing the 3 days when he was in the grave?
  - o Spirits in prison
  - o What is Sheol? The place where people go in the OT or pre-cross when they die:
    - One side is Hades/Gehenna – Luke 16:19-25 (The rich man and Lazarus)
      - You can see into Abrahams' Bosom
      - Speaks of both OT sides of Sheol
      - You can feel pain in Hades
      - Prison is always a picture of Hades
    - One side is Abrahams' Bosom/Side
      - You can see into Hades
      - Believers in the messiah to come
  - o Jesus comes down in 1 Pt 3:19 to Sheol and preaches a message.
    - The same aroma of Christ is death to some and life to some
    - He preaches a message that he is the Messiah
      - He condemns those of rejected him
      - He redeems those who believe and go to be with Christ

- Jesus didn't go down to Hell, he went to Sheol

#### Matthew 14:22-33 Peter walking on the water

- **Chaos** – v. 24: the storm
- **Water** – v. 24: beaten by the waves
- **Spirit over the water** – v. 26: It's a ghost (Jesus)
  - A spirit over the water to Jews is always God, Jesus coming out on the water is him saying...I'M GOD
  - When Jesus walked on the water the disciples realize:
    - Job 9:4-8 – He = God, treads on the waves of the sea
    - Psalm 77:16-20 – God's footprints are unseen and the only way that is possible is if he walks on water
- God speaks – v. 27: Take heart, it is I, **do not be afraid**
  - Fear not are the first words to Zechariah
  - Fear not are the first words to Mary
  - Fear not are the first words to the shepherds
  - What Jesus is saying in Hebrew each time is that he is I AM
    - I AM = I always and God and always has been and always will
- Expected order
- Testing – v. 29: Peter gets the test
  - Up to this point every human has failed the test until Jesus in the wilderness. Peter after Jesus fails the test showing again, only Jesus can pass the test in the cycle.

#### Side Notes

- A lot of ministry goes on in the home. Children learn the most about the scriptures at home. The father was the priest of the home. He led his family through the prayers, Passover, festivals, and traditions.
- You know Jesus is telling a true story, rather than a parable, when he names a person in it.
- Satan is not *all knowing* and *can't see the future*, but he can see **patterns** that will make you stumble.
- Every Gospel writer has a plan/theme and are trying to prove something with their gospel
- 3 themes of Matthew:
  - The Messiah is of the lineage of David
  - God with us: Matthew 28 – this is the long awaited God they have been waiting for
  - Jesus is the picture of Moses:
    - Feeding of the 5 thousand – Moses fed a big crowd with mana
    - Jesus walk on water – Moses walked on water with the red sea
- ***Some try so hard to get through the storm and miss the lesson God is trying to teach through the season/journey.***

- Put yourself in the Biblical accounts as you are reading.
  - The Jewish people knew the Old Testament so well that when Jesus came on the scene and they put their faith in Him, all the questions are answered because Jesus fills in the Old Testament blanks. The Old Testament brings full light to the entire Bible.
