Discussion Questions

1. Satan likes for us to be confused so we don't know what God really said.

Do you think it would be easier or harder to follow God's commands if you don't know what He really said?

- Perhaps play the Telephone Game with instructions to do a dance or an exercise. When the instructions aren't clear, you might end up looking pretty silly.
- God is orderly. He didn't create fish before He created the oceans. If he did, they wouldn't have a place to live. Instead, He created everything in the perfect order so every animal and every plant had a home waiting for it. We see God's orderliness beginning with creation and all throughout the Bible.
- God created our world with certain rules that apply to everyone and everything. Gravity always makes things fall down, not up. No matter what you drop, it will fall. God's rules don't change, even if it would be fun. Can you imagine if our dirty clothes would float to the ceiling when we drop them?
- When we follow God and His commands, the Bible says we are blessed. (Genesis 1:28-31).



2. Jesus tells us what is true. Satan asks, “Is it really?” He wants us to question what God said so we don’t know the right thing to do (Genesis 3:1).

- Consider playing the game, “Two Truths and a Lie.”
- Sometimes it’s hard to tell the difference between a lie and the truth. Has anyone ever told a story and you weren’t sure if it was true or made up?
- If we think something is true long enough, we can believe it is true even if it’s not.

3. Satan would love for us to all be mad at each other. Jesus says we should love one another (John 13:34-35). However, we must be able to tell God’s truth from Satan’s lies and not be afraid to share God’s truth with love.

- Nobody is perfect, and we are all sinners (Romans 3:23).
- We should all do our best to follow Jesus and obey God’s commands instead of what we want to do (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
