Questions for Families

Here are some questions you can discuss with the whole family.

Luke 14:24-33

What do you think Jesus means when he says we should love him more than our family? Guide for Parents: For younger children, explain that Jesus wants to be the most important in our hearts, even more important than things or people we love. For older children, discuss how this means putting Jesus first in making choices and living our lives.

Why do you think Jesus talks about thinking carefully before deciding to follow him? What does this teach us about making big decisions?

Guide for Parents: Encourage younger children to share examples of big decisions they have made or seen, like choosing a school activity. For older children, talk about the importance of understanding responsibilities and being prepared to commit to decisions fully.

How can we show that we are true followers of Jesus in our daily lives?

Guide for Parents: Help younger kids brainstorm simple actions like sharing, being kind, or praying. With older children, discuss more complex ideas like showing honesty, helping others in need, or standing up for what's right, even when it's hard.
