Questions to consider and discuss with your group this week.

APPLY How does the idea that God can "reverse the curse" and reshape our lives despite our past mistakes impact your view of your own life?

Questions for Families

Here are some questions you can discuss with the whole family.

Acts 2:37-41

What does this story show us about God's plan for His people?

For younger children, explain that God wanted people to know and follow Jesus, and He gave them the Holy Spirit to help them. With older kids, discuss how Pentecost fulfilled God's promise and how He was starting something new—the church.

Why do you think the people felt "cut to the heart" when Peter spoke?

Guide younger children to understand that they realized they had made a big mistake and wanted to make it right. With older kids, discuss how they recognized their sin, saw their need for Jesus, and responded with repentance.

How did the people show they truly wanted to follow Jesus, and how can we do the same?

For younger children, talk about how the people listened to Peter, repented, and were baptized to show they loved Jesus. With older kids, discuss how true faith leads to action—repenting, being baptized, and living in a way that honors God.
