Two Wedding Invitations

Week of November 3, 2024

Spirit-Led Follower: How has the Word of God been shaping you recently?

Text

Have someone read aloud [Revelation 19:11-21](#)

These two invitations in Revelation contrast what it will look like for those in Christ and those opposed to Christ. Christ has already won the victory. The question is, will we bow the knee to him as Lord and Savior or as Judge? Which invitation are we responding to? And for those in Christ, how do we wait ready with anticipation for the day of Jesus' return?

Discussion Questions

1. What does this Supper of God represent, and how do we see Jesus achieve victory over His enemies?
2. What does the imagery used in this passage tell us about Jesus and His enemy?

Have someone read aloud [Revelation 19:6-10](#)

3. How is our invitation to the marriage feast of Christ a gift, and how does it impact the Christian's life?
4. What attributes of God do we see displayed through the two scenes? Which attribute of God stands out the most to you and why?
5. In what ways does Revelation 19 highlight Jesus' victory over sin and death?



Application

1. How is Jesus' word (the "sword of His mouth") central to His victory? How can you incorporate more of His Word into your life?
2. How does the fact that Jesus has already won the battle over sin and death impact how we battle sin in our lives today?
3. What does it look like to live a life of anticipation for the marriage feast of Jesus?

Prayer

At the end of your conversation, spend some time praying as a group. Here are some prompts:

1. Thank God for His faithfulness in securing our salvation through Jesus' sacrifice, and ask for His help in living as a testament to His grace.
2. Spend time praying for our church, community, and country.
