# **Revelation Series: Revelation 5:8-10**

Week of April 21, 2024

#### **Text**

Have someone read aloud Revelation 5:8-10.

As the remainder of Revelation unfolds, it is key for us to view it in the light of the beginning of Revelation chapter 5. The four living creatures, 24 elders, and all of creation declare the worthiness of Jesus Christ the slain lamb and conquering Lion of Judah. As <a href="Philippians 2">Philippians 2</a> reminds us "every knee will bow and every tongue confess." The most important question is will you bow the knee now and confess Him as your Lord and Savior or bow your knee at the judgment to Him as Lord and Judge?

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. What are you looking forward to the most now that the weather has warmed back up?
- 2. In this passage, we see a lot of references to various Old Testament passages. Which Old Testament connection stands out to you the most, and how does that affect your understanding of the Book of Revelation? (Examples: Genesis 12:1-3, Exodus 19:4-6)
- 3. How would you describe the role or job of a kingdom of priests, and how did this role change or stay the same between the Old and New Testaments?
- 4. How does the biblical definition of reigning compare to the world's definition of reigning?

# **Application**

1. As a kingdom of priests called to be holy, what does it mean to be set apart from the world around us?



2. What is a way you can bring the Kingdom of God to earth this week for those in your circle of impact?

## **Prayer**

At the end of your conversation, spend some time praying as a group. Here are some prompts:

- 1. Pray the Lord would empower us to be holy and set apart for His glory and for the Kingdom of God.
- 2. Prayer Prompts from the Tuesday Night Prayer Meeting.
  - Confession/Submission/Humility Set the tone for private, personal, and silent confession, praying for God to show us the right things to be praying for (<u>Ex 33:12-23</u>) and to have the correct posture of heart (<u>James 4:2-3</u>).
  - Spiritual warfare <u>Ephesians 6:10-20</u> We should be praying against it, individually and as a body.
  - Intercession Praying for the road ahead for leadership (Pastor Robby, lead team, MAC team, staff, etc.), making decisions through prayer, Gallatin Church launch, Hendersonville Campus expansion, and local and global initiatives.
