### Text

*Have someone read aloud [Revelation 22:1-5](#).*

In this week's discussion, we explore Revelation 22 and examine what will be included in the New Heaven and Earth. Reflecting on the promise of a restored creation, delve into how this vision of a new city, culture, creativity, and Christ's presence can transform our lives today. How does anticipating a tangible, redeemed Earth influence our stewardship of the world around us? Consider how utilizing our God-given talents now is preparation for our eternal roles. Let's discuss how these insights can shape our daily walk with Christ and our community.

### Discussion Questions

1. How does the idea of a new city in Heaven challenge your previous perceptions?
2. What are your thoughts on the concept that we'll have responsibilities and roles in Heaven? How does this differ from the idea of an eternal day off?
3. How does the idea that our current lives are training for reigning change your perspective on daily challenges and opportunities?

*Have someone read aloud [Isaiah 65:17-19](#).*

4. What elements of joy and renewal are highlighted in both Revelation and Isaiah?
5. What does this description of Heaven show you about the character of God?



## **Application**

Have someone read aloud [1 Corinthians 13:12](#).

1. What does it mean to you to have a longing for Jesus?
2. Why is it important to continue growing as a disciple of Jesus and what does this look like?
3. How are you currently growing in Christ? What's one step you can take to deepen your growth as a disciple?
4. What is one God-given talent you have? How can you use that talent this week to serve others and glorify God?

## **Prayer**

At the end of your conversation, spend some time praying as a group. Here is a prompt:

Thank God for the hope of heaven and ask for His help in living with an eternal perspective this week.
