

## **The Forgotten Jesus Podcast**

**Title - Eastern Thinking vs. our Western Perspective.**

**Description - On this episode, Pastor Robby shares a personal story on how he first came to view scriptures with an eastern, Hebraic mindset.**

When Robby was saved, he came to the bible with zero biblical knowledge. He grew up Catholic, but never read the bible.

Sometimes you have to read a book and learn from a resource the way a Cajun eats a fish. You've got to eat the meat carefully and spit out the bones.

The oral word for the Jewish culture was just as important as the written word.

There are three messianic miracles: (Some say 4)

1. Healing a deaf, lame man
2. Healing a leper
3. Healing a man born blind
4. Raising someone from the dead

Dwight Pryor – Robby considers him his Rabbi, one of his mentors.

Started a ministry called JC Studies.

Robby went to a retreat with Dr. Pryor and at the retreat, his roommate was a messianic Jewish rabbi. He was born Jewish, and had become a Christian, recognizing that Jesus was the long-awaited Jewish Messiah.

Why was Jesus's first miracle at a Wedding? - It tied back to Exodus when Moses came down with the law, and said to the people, these are the commands of God, who will be your God if you will have him, but you must keep his laws & commands. Moses was orchestrating a wedding between God and his people.

The OT is the only testament Jesus had.

So Jesus didn't come to abolish the law, he came to fulfill it, to make it complete.

Keshet & Remez – think of Velcro – connections and ties back from the New Testament to the Old Testament.

Every time Jesus opens his mouth to speak, he's quoting the old testament or a teaching from the old testament.

In this podcast, we're going to give you some training wheels to try to make the connections between the old and new testament, particularly the Gospels.

The goal is always to grow in our love and knowledge of Jesus.
