All Authority Belongs To Jesus - (Mark 1:29-31)

Description – Jesus has all authority, but what does that mean? Join us today as we look at some of the areas in scripture where we see Jesus displaying authority.

Jesus has authority to teach

Jesus has authority over the demonic world

Jesus has authority over nature

Jesus even delegates his authority to others, when he sends out the disciples.

One of the big confusions for some Christians today is that they think that Jesus broke the law. But how could God break the law He had created and given to Moses?

When the Pharisees accused Jesus of breaking the law, it was not the written law of God. He kept that perfectly. What they were upset about is that Jesus was ignoring tradition, the oral law, the added rules and regulations they had setup over the centuries to try to protect them from breaking the written law.

Prolegomena - a technical theological term. Refers to the setup questions that lead into the main topic.

Mark 1:29-31

²⁹ As soon as they left the synagogue, they went into Simon and Andrew's house with James and John. ³⁰ Simon's mother-in-law was lying in bed with a fever, and they told him about her at once. ³¹ So he went to her, took her by the hand, and raised her up. The fever left her, and she began to serve them.

Notice what day Jesus is healing on here: The Sabbath. (1:29). They'd just left him teaching at the synagouge.

Also of note, that Peter has a mother in law, meaning that he was married.
