

Senior Adult Care Team Guidelines for Visiting Facilities

- 1. Two or more adults should always be present during in-person contact with facility residents. An adult must accompany children.
- 2. All in-person contact with individuals and visits to facilities should be during daytime/recommended hours (Tues., Thurs., Fri., Sat., beginning at 10:30 AM, with none overnight).
- Only medical professionals employed by the facility may administer medications. Volunteers may not administer medications or provide personal hygiene services, i.e. bathing, changing clothes, etc.
- 4. Volunteers should check with facility staff (Life Enrichment Coordinator or nurse) before providing food assistance or snacks.
- 5. Volunteers should coordinate with staff (Life Enrichment Coordinator) before joining or starting any group activity.
- 6. Consider a modest approach to clothing, as this will help connect you to those you are visiting. (Know your audience!)
- A criminal background check must be completed through Long Hollow Church and notification of approval received for persons 18 and over before participating.

- 8. If a conflict arises between the LH Care Ministry Team, facility staff, and myself, I agree to resolve the dispute outside the secular court system through biblical reconciliation under submission to and the direction of Long Hollow Church's Deacon body representatives. (1 Cor. 6:1-8)
- 9. Privacy is essential. Please do not share names or any personal information with others outside the facility.
- 10. Be aware of illness signage on the doors of individual rooms. Do not enter a room with an illness sign on the door.
