

The Forgotten Jesus Podcast Discussion Guide Season 4, Episode 19

Casting Out Demons, The Second Messianic Miracle

Today, we're examining the encounter of Jesus with a demon-possessed man who was both blind and mute. There's more to this story in Matthew 12 than just miraculous healing.

Introduction

Recap: Last week on *The Forgotten Jesus Podcast*, we looked at the story of the healing of a man with leprosy and the question, "Why did Jesus tell some people to share what He had done and tell others not to share?"

Take a few minutes to discuss this week's episode and what stuck out to everyone.

Discussion

Have someone read aloud Mark 5:1-13

- 1. How does the context of the question of the disciples in <u>Mark 4:41</u> impact the reading of Mark 5?
- 2. What is the difference between believing and following Jesus?

Have someone read aloud Matthew 12:22-24

- 3. What is the significance of the crowd's question?
- 4. Why do you think the Pharisees did not believe in Jesus even after this and other Messianic miracles?

Application:

Take some time to apply what you have discussed.

- 1. Why do you think so many people believe that Jesus was just a good man, and why is that not a logical response to Jesus?
- 2. What would you say to someone who claims to believe Jesus was a real man (good teacher) but not the Son of God?
- 3. Who is someone you know who needs to hear the Gospel or hear the Gospel again?

For next week: How many times do the demons beg in Mark 5, and what is the one request Jesus does not grant?
