The Finger Of God And The Vows Of The Kingdom

Join us today as we talk about what keeping God's covenant requires on our part.

Introduction

Recap: Last week on *The Forgotten Jesus Podcast*, we talked about the marriage ceremony on Mt. Sinai and the covenant or marriage vows for that marriage.

Take a few minutes to discuss this week's episode and what stuck out to everyone.

1. How would you describe vows and the role they play in a marriage or another aspect of life?

Discussion

Have someone read aloud [Exodus 24:1-4](#).

1. How did the Israelites respond to the covenant vows and how does this response compare to how we are called to respond to the new covenant we are under?

Have someone read aloud [Deuteronomy 9:10](#) and [Luke 11:20](#).

2. Why do you think the Bible uses human traits or features to describe God, and is there a specific example that stands out to you? Why?
3. How does this usage of human traits and features help us understand the commandments and power of God better?



Application:

Take some time to apply what you have discussed.

1. How has your view of the laws of God evolved through your walk with God?
2. How have the commandments of God been uniquely life giving for you in your walk with Christ?
3. How do you need to trust in God's commands and power in your own life this week?

For next week: When does redemption happen, and when does the law come down?

Pray

Share prayer requests and pray as a group at the end of your conversation. Here are some prompts:

1. Pray we would experience the power of God in our lives through the Holy Spirit.
2. Pray the Lord would empower us to respond in obedience to His commands. If there is something specific you need help to be obedient in, pray for that.
