The Forgotten Jesus Podcast Discussion Guide Season 4, Episode 5 You Can't Have Pentecost Without Passover

A pattern we begin to unravel in this episode is: Redemption leads to revelation, which then demands responsibility. Join us today as we examine this pattern in the Old and New Testament.

Introduction

Recap: Last week on *The Forgotten Jesus Podcast*, we discussed the finger of God and how God works through the power of His covenantal law.

Take a few minutes to discuss this week's episode and what stuck out to everyone.

1. How are Passover and Pentecost connected between the Old and New Testament?

Discussion

Have someone read aloud Acts 1:1-3, Acts 2:37-41, and Exodus 32:27-28.

- 1. How do these connections between the Old Testament and the New Testament highlight God's sovereignty and His plan throughout all of Scripture?
- 2. How does the question, "What should we do?" reflect the pattern of responsibility following revelation? How does Peter's response echo the covenantal aspect seen in the Old Testament?
- 3. Looking ahead, where do you anticipate seeing this redemption, revelation, responsibility pattern in the New Testament?



Application:

Take some time to apply what you have discussed.

- 1. What is the difference between "I must obey God to be saved, and I must obey God because I'm saved," and how does this affect the way we live our lives?
- 2. How has the pattern of "Redemption Revelation Responsibility" shaped the church, and how has it shaped your Christian walk?

For next week: See if you can chart out these events: Passover, Pentecost, and 3,000 being killed. Compare them to their New Testament counterparts to see the significance in these specific numbers and timetable.

- 1. Pray that God would continue to reveal more of himself to us.
- 2. Pray that God would move us to obey out of the grace we have received and not to trying to earn grace.
