Demonology 201: The 5 Major Attacks of Demons Mark 1:21-28

Icebreaker & Opening Prayer

- Icebreaker: Have you ever experienced an unexplainable spiritual attack or moment of oppression? How did you respond?
- Pray asking the Holy Spirit to guide your understanding and discussion regarding spiritual warfare.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What stands out to you in Mark 1:21-28 about Jesus' authority over demons?
- 2. Why do you think the people in the synagogue were astonished at Jesus' teaching? How did His authority differ from that of the scribes?
- 3. The demon in Mark 1:24 recognizes Jesus as "the Holy One of God." Why is it significant that demons know who Jesus is?
- 4. How does Jesus' command for the demon to be silent and come out demonstrate His divine authority?
- 5. Pastor Robby mentioned five ways demons attack people (Impression, Repression, Obsession, Oppression, and Possession). Which of these do you think is most prevalent today?
- 6. Read 1 Timothy 4:1-2. How do "deceitful spirits" influence people away from the faith?

- 7. In Matthew 13:18-19 and 2 Corinthians 4:4, we see that Satan seeks to blind people from the truth. What are some modern-day examples of this happening?
- 8. Why is it dangerous to become obsessed with the demonic or occult, even if it seems innocent?
- 9. According to Ephesians 1:13-14, believers are sealed by the Holy Spirit. Why is this an important truth in spiritual warfare?
- 10. What can we learn from Numbers 23:23 and Job 1:8 about God's sovereignty over the enemy?

Application Questions

- 1. How can recognizing Jesus' authority over spiritual forces strengthen your faith?
- 2. In what ways can you guard your mind against demonic impression and deception?
- 3. Are there any areas in your life where you feel spiritually repressed or blinded to truth? How can you seek God's clarity?
- 4. Have you ever been distracted or obsessed with spiritual warfare, rather than focusing on Christ? How can you reorient your focus?
- 5. What practical steps can you take to resist demonic oppression in your daily life?
- 6. How can Scripture be used as a weapon against the enemy's attacks?
- 7. Are there any lies from the enemy that you have believed? How does God's Word counter those lies?
- 8. What role does the community of believers play in helping one another fight spiritual battles?
- 9. How can you encourage someone who is struggling with spiritual attacks?
- 10. What specific action will you take this week to deepen your reliance on Jesus' authority in your life?

Closing Prayer & Challenge

- Pray for protection, wisdom, and discernment in spiritual matters. Ask God to strengthen the group's trust in Jesus' power over the enemy.
- Challenge: Memorize Ephesians 6:10-11 *"Finally, be strengthened by the Lord and by his vast strength. Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil."*
